Thank you for your strong stand against New York Regional Interconnect, Inc.'s (NYRI) request for National Interest Electric Transmission Corridor (NIETC) status. It is reassuring to know you agree that this proposed power line would devastate the environment, local economies, property values and the futures of families living in much of Upstate New York.

Now, I hope you will add your powerful voice to those of thousands of families who live in Upstate and who are saying NYRI should not be built at all. NYRI is not just bad for we who live here, but it is bad for all New Yorkers.
